



# HIGH SCHOOL PROFILE CLASS OF 2023–2024

#### SCHOOL AND COMMUNITY

- Founded in 2010 to serve the educational needs of children living in Addis Ababa and the Oromia Regions. While the school is open to the general public for a moderate fee, the children from the nearby orphanage run by St. Mother Teresa's Community do not have to pay
- We have over 40 teachers teaching high school with multiple staff assisting in the education. The student-to-teacher ratio is about 25:1.
- Most students pay a moderate fee to attend school, but low-income students receive assistance from the school.
- All students are Ethiopian nationals and ethnically Black.
- The primary language of instruction is English except for language classes.

## CURRICULUM AND ACCREDITATION — GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

- St John Baptist De La Salle Catholic School is accredited by the Ministry of Education and Addis Ababa City Education Bureau.
- After their sophomore year, students will either choose to enroll in Natural Sciences-based education or Social Sciences-based education for the rest of their two years in high school. For those choosing a Natural sciences-based curriculum, the courses will predominantly be STEM courses. For those choosing a Social sciences-based curriculum, the courses will predominantly be social science & humanities courses. However, both will be taking common courses like English, Math, and Information Communication Technology.
- To graduate from our high school, students will have to do 4 years of high school on a curriculum based on the one outlined by the Ministry of Education they have to pass both the university entrance examination and meet the school's passing criteria.

- We do not yet offer IB, AP, or IGCSE courses. The courses we offer are based on the curriculum devised by the Ministry of Education.
- Subjects offered include:

  - o Agriculture (STEM)
  - o Amharic (Language)
  - o Biology (STEM)
  - Chemistry (STEM)
  - Citizenship (Humanities)
  - Civics and Ethical Education (Humanities)

  - Geography (Social Science)
  - History (Humanities)
  - Information Communication Technology (STEM)
  - Mathematics (STEM)
  - o Physical and Health Education (STEM)

  - o Technical Drawing (STEM discontinued)
- Some other courses that are not evaluated might be taken by some students. We have been offering different language courses such as Italian and French, and other courses like Visual Arts and Music for students. We also offer a one-credit Laboratory course that fits into the Biology, Chemistry, and Physics courses.

### GRADING AND RANKING

- In each grade, we have divided students into alphabetized sections. For instance, the class of 2024 is divided into 4 sections named A, B, C, & D. While the former two are students enrolled in Natural sciences-based courses, the latter two are enrolled in Social sciences-based courses. Each section holds an average of 50 students.
- Class rank is calculated separately for each section based on students' average performance on the subjects out of 100%. All subjects have equal weight.
- GPA is calculated by the school and we provide a table of letter grades on each transcript we offer. St John is known for one of the most rigorous academics and grading scales in the city - we won the award for the best high school education provider in the sub-city and are contenders for the citywide competition.
- The school year is divided into quarters and major exams such as midterms & finals are offered each quarter. However, evaluations are given each semester.

#### SCHOOL RIGOR AND AWARDS

- Our school, although relatively new, has consistently been performing superbly in national examinations.
   For instance, the class of 2022, was one of the only two dozen high schools out of the many thousands in the country to have accomplished a 100% pass rate.
   For this accomplishment, our school was awarded and certified by the Prime Minister of the country.
- For the class of 2022, 14 of the top 200 scorers of the Secondary School Leaving Certificate Examination were our students. Upwards of 600,000 people took the exam in the whole country.

This only goes to show the rigor of the academics offered in our school compared to the national average.
